Honduras Mission Trip August 2009 Accepting Registrations Now

St. Andrew Lutheran Church is planning a weeklong mission trip to Yuscaran, Honduras August 5 to 12, 2009

The weeklong Mission trip includes construction work, primarily cement & cinderblock construction on the church building in Yuscaran. There is also plenty of opportunity to work with children in Yuscaran via Day Camp.

The cost is being estimated at \$595 per person, plus airfare. The costs include all accommodations, all meals & clean water, insurance, ground transportation.

Accommodations are in cabins with bunk beds, flush toilets are located outside of the cabins, as are showers. Solar showers are an option that work well.

A typical week includes five working days from 9 to 4 in the village, evenings are free and relaxing. Sunday is a sabbath in the true sense of the word.

There is an option to add a post-mission week trip to Copan to see the Mayan ruins. Additional costs are incurred for this post week trip.

As of the writing of this newsletter airfare is currently \$483 round trip from Boston.

This is a week of hands on Short Term Mission work. The experience is life changing, faith building and a true renewal.
