Breakfast at Hotel, followed by Brief morning orientation and worship

We will take day trips during the week to a variety of churches and mission centers. The sites will range from simple preaching points that are in the early stages of development. Many of these churches are looking for partner congregations to work on such projects as vacation bible schools, church construction, small business development, medical and/or dental clinics.

We will be in the Northwestern part of Honduras, and we also hope to make part of one day trip to the Mayan Ruins in Copan or a similar area.

On Friday evening, we will gather as a group for closing worship with our Honduran friends. Following this worship, we will have discussions about future plans for your churches partnership. Included will be an orientation on how to lead a Mission trip.

Saturday, February 16 Depart San Pedro Sula, saying goodbye to our new friends, and renewed with a vision for future partnerships. Return to Boston around 9:00 p.m.
